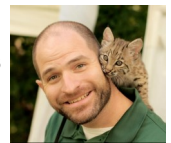
MONDAY, JUNE 20th

MONDAY, JUNE 27th



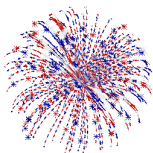
