

Oak Ridge Community Calendar Policy

The purpose of the Oak Ridge Community Calendar is to connect residents of Oak Ridge with events open to the general public such as sporting events, festivals, concerts, recitals, and gallery shows in addition to giving local non-profit and community organizations an opportunity to publicize events. The calendar is not intended to promote for-profit events such as sales or grand openings or other events that would fall under the purview of the Chamber of Commerce; recurring classes that require registration or fees such as exercise or other classes; weekly religious services; political campaign events; or meetings and events that are not open to the general public. This calendar is not intended to serve as official notice of public meetings.

In keeping with City policy E-210 which states “The Code of Conduct for City facilities prohibits any type of verbal abuse, racial slurs, profanity, or vulgar language,” the Community Calendar will not include events hosted by organizations that engender hatred or abuse towards any protected class.

The City of Oak Ridge, Tennessee, does not discriminate based on race, creed, color, national origin, age, sex, sexual orientation, disability, religion, or other legally protected status in admission to, access to, or operations of its programs, services, or activities.
